MEMBERSHIP FORM

Individual memberships are \$15 per year; family memberships are \$25 per year. The membership year is September 1 to the following August 31. Thus, if you join JID after March 1 of any calendar year, dues are pro-rated to \$7.50 for individuals, or \$12.50 for families, for a membership for the remaining part of the membership year.

Members of JID need not be Jackson residents, and need not be dancers; all that is required for membership is that you have an interest in learning, performing, or supporting Irish dance and the activities of JID. Our performance group is selected from among the membership, and members receive discounted admission to JID events and classes wherever possible, as well as other benefits. Members of the board of directors of JID are elected by the membership from among our members; directors must be residents of the Jackson metropolitan area.

Individual (\$15 from Sept. 1 to Feb. 28; \$7.50 from March 1 to Aug. 31; all memberships expire Aug. 31).

Family (\$25 from Sept. 1 to Feb. 28; \$12.50 from March 1 to Aug. 31; all memberships expire Aug. 31).

Please note: family members must live in the same household; also, if your dancer is under 18, a family (rather than individual) membership is required.
